



HOLIDAY DECORATING

The following guidelines have been prepared to assist you with your exterior holiday decorating. By following these guidelines we will capture the festive spirit without infringing on each other's privacy or tranquility and still be in compliance with the declaration and house rules.

- 1. Decorations can be in place from the day following Thanksgiving until January 15th. These guidelines cover all limited common elements. (Decks, patios, and terraces.) Please refrain from placing personal decorations in the common elements (planter boxes, garage, reception areas, hallways).**
- 2. During this time of year an exception is made to permit wreaths to be hung on the outside of your door. Please do not use nails, screws or any device that penetrates the surface. Local hardware stores have hangers that hang over the top of the door that will hold a wreath.**
- 3. For those who have not switched to artificial trees, you will be able to dispose of your live tree on the property. Please do not place trees in the green dumpsters. Place trees behind the building on the south side under the viaduct. PLEASE DO NOT ATTEMPT TO PUT TREES DOWN THE TRASH CHUTES.**
- 4. Please use a sheet or plastic to carry trees to and from your unit. This will prevent needles from dropping on the carpets.**
- 5. There are various tapes you can use to secure lights on decks, patios and terraces. (No trees in these areas, please.) Please make sure all lights are secured to prevent any damages in the event of high winds. Use a tape that removes easily without causing damage to the surfaces.**
